

## Good choice on contractor

After severe flooding some months ago at the west end of Avenue Road — at which time some residents suffered considerable loss from water damage — the Town of Newmarket undertook to ensure this situation would not reoccur.

The plan was to install a diversion pipe changing the course of the stream.

New pipes were installed for water, sewage and surface drains along with new and additional fire hydrants.

Due to gravity flow, the pipe sits deep in the street, more than 20 feet most of the way.

Many residents, myself included, have been favourably impressed by the continued courtesy and kind acts of the people employed by contractor Clearway Construction.

The great amount of excavation, replaced by aggregate, curbing, sidewalks, road pavement, etc., has been a dawn-to-dusk effort for many weeks.

I would like to thank these hard workers and, in particular, project supervisor Steve Pilon for his daily courtesy and help to the residents, who were sometimes inconvenienced by the construction. The town made a good choice in this contractor.
